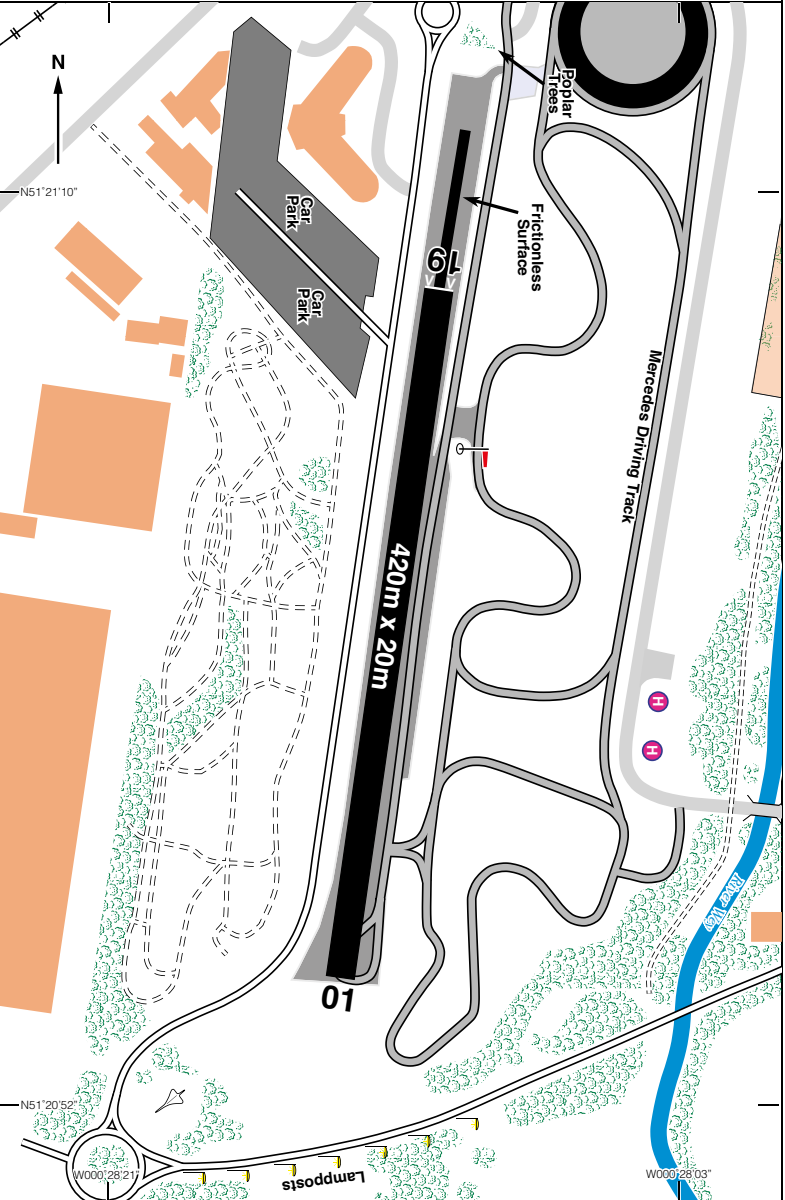

All movements when the Brooklands LFA is closed must obtain clearance to enter/leave the London CTR from Heathrow Radar 125•625.

Non Radio aircraft are prohibited.

Taxiing: Pilots must exercise caution when taxiing over the frictionless surface to the north of the strip

Circuits: To the west of the strip remaining within the confines of the LFA when activated.

Warnings: Aerodrome in London CTR (Class 'D') see Local Flying Area (LFA) Chart opposite.

Pilots of suitably equipped aircraft shall operate their transponders with altitude information when flying in the LFA.

Restaurant: Full restaurant facilities at Brooklands Museum.

 1. Flight visibility of 5km or greater. 2. Maximum altitude 1500ft QNH. 3. Acft remain below cloud and in sight of the ground. 4. No separation is provided by Heathrow SVFR either between acft flying within the LFA, or between acft within the LFA and other acft in the London CTR.
